ADMISSIONS POLICY

The school serves Hyde Heath village and the surrounding district. Applications from outside the immediate area are welcome and places will be offered within the intended admission number (currently 22 for a year group) and in accordance with the criteria for Community schools listed in the Local Authority Guide for Parents - Admission to Buckinghamshire Primary Schools.

The School's Admission Policy provides for the admission of all children, full-time, in the September following their fourth birthday.

- Parents can request that their child attends part-time until full-time attendance is mutually agreed between parents and the school or until the child reaches compulsory school age, whichever is sooner/most appropriate
- Parents can request that the date their child is admitted is deferred until later in the school year or until the child reaches compulsory school age in that school year

Please note: where entry is deferred, the Local Authority will hold the place for that child and not offer it to another child. However, the parent would not be able to defer entry beyond the beginning of the term after the child's fifth birthday, or beyond the academic year for which the original application was accepted.

An Open Morning is usually held in the Autumn Term, when parents of prospective pupils are invited to view the school and meet the Headteacher. Details can be obtained from the School Office.

Visits to the School can also be arranged at other times during the year, for in-year admissions.
